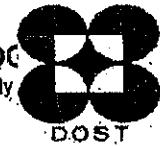

## **TSUNAMI ALERT LEVEL 2**

### **Be on Alert for Unusual Waves**

A strong local earthquake occurred offshore Negros Oriental at 11:49 AM, 06 February 2012 (Philippine Time), located at 9.97 °N, 123.14 °E with depth of 10 km and a preliminary magnitude of 6.9.

PHIVOLCS Tsunami Alert Level is now **2**. The concerned public is advised to **BE ON ALERT FOR UNUSUAL WAVES**.

People are advised to **stay away from the shoreline**. People should not go to the coast to watch the tsunami. People whose houses are very near coastal areas of Negros and Cebu Islands are strongly advised to be watchful.
